Preface

Klaus Schwab of the World Economic Forum, a major player and his major global forum for corporations and individuals, announced the Fourth Industrial Revolution in May 2019, in a Brochure, Centre for the Fourth Industrial Revolution Network for Global Technology Governance:

"The First Industrial Revolution introduced the use of steam power to mechanize production. The Second Industrial Revolution saw a number of groundbreaking inventions in transport, telecommunications and manufacturing, including the use of electric power to generate mass production. The Third Industrial Revolution brought the internet and other technological innovations, which have ushered humanity into the digital era."

"Today, society is undergoing a Fourth Industrial Revolution, an age in which scientific and technological breakthroughs are disrupting industries, blurring geographical boundaries, challenging existing regulatory frameworks, and even redefining what it means to be human." This was followed in 2020 by his book, <u>COVID-19 - The Great Reset</u>. From the WEF website, <u>Now is the time for a 'great reset</u>':

"To achieve a better outcome, the world must act jointly and swiftly to revamp all aspects of our societies and economies, from education to social contracts and working conditions. Every country, from the United States to China, must participate, and every industry, from oil and gas to tech, must be transformed. In short, we need a "Great Reset" of capitalism."

"We can emerge from this crisis a better world, if we act quickly and jointly. The changes we have already seen in response to Covid-19 prove that a reset of our economic and social foundations is possible. This is our best chance to instigate stakeholder capitalism."

The Global Coup, an expression I often use to describe the current events taking place since the rollout of Covid, has actually been going on for much much longer; they (the Rockefellers, the bankers, the United Nations ...) have been playing the long game. But with the rollout of Covid and Klaus Schwab's Great Reset, the Global Coup is now much more out in the open and changes towards its New Order are accelerating. This is manifest in disruptive technology, in the financial world, in media, in the field of health care (fear being the easiest way to manipulate people), in a movement to restrict basic human rights, and with every aspect of this, a massive broad comprehensive psyop.

It is important to know about the history of the globalists to really get the big picture, but, as reflected in the title of this PDF, the scope of this paper is a focus on the activities of the major players involved in the current push for a Great Reset.

Because of that focus, this PDF will not go into a deep history of the players. For example, the Rockefellers have been active megalomaniac technocrats for over a hundred years but here (excepting an occasional reference) only their recent and, in particular, Covid era actions and connections will be looked at. Also there is, of course, the deep state manipulation of global geo-politics that is a part of the Global Coup, but here the focus remains on the recent and current drive to socially engineer and entrap humanity.

This PDF will demonstrate by naming names and connecting dots to show how this Great Reset is global in nature and the endgame (which is taking place now) is total (digital) control of everyone and every aspect of life on Earth, as well as our very human natural physical lives as well.

Note, however, that this document covers only the players and projects and connections I have become aware of. There are many many more at all levels of the Global Coup and there are certainly many significant players around the world who are not listed here, but who also deserve the infamy. Follow the links to explore the depths.

Aspects of the Great Reset (and Global Coup) to Look For

Following is short list of some of the aspects of the global coup to look for in the activities or involvements of the players and the things they collaborate on:

- Public / Private partnerships; players with public responsibility with ties to corporations or big money, multinational corporations joining governments.
- Central bank digital currencies and the like, commodifying everything, including Nature itself, using finance as a weapon.
- Bio-tech, bio-weapons, including vaccines, Big Pharma, and overuse of drugs, any player or collaboration leveraging the Covid psyop.
- United Nations projects, planning how the world should run in their image, global governance, anyone or thing that describes their work as "sustainable".
- Taking advantage of the Climate Change doom narrative, such as reorganizing society, carbon trading, policy or regulating behavior based on the narrative.
- Things such as digital ID, surveillance, data collection, needing passes for access.
- Censorship, control of speech, tailored search algorithms.
- Disruptive technology reshaping the way we live Smart Cities, Strong Cities, 15 Minute Cities, 5G, Internet of Things, Al for everything.
- Controlling the food supply, buying up land, killing livestock because of climate and bird flu, etc.
- Social engineering, i.e. plans, projects, laws, mandates that force or compel society and individuals in a direction desirable to those who would want to control us.

The Four Parts of This Document

The document is divided into two main parts, and two lesser parts:

- Part 1, *Individuals and Organizations*, is names of mostly people but some organizations. See its preface for more about this part.
- Part 2, *Projects and Collaborations*, is listing of various projects playing roles in the Great Reset / Global Coup, many of them involving the collaboration of the players listed in the Part 1. See its preface for more about this part.
- Part 3, *Covid's Foot Soldiers*, is players whose actions and connections may not be as global and as extensive as the players in Part 1 but who were very active in the promoting of the Covid psyop.

Part 4, A Few More Lists of Players to Explore, is links to more sources for researching players.

Part 1 and Part 2 each have their own table of contents, with links to sections the players and projects are divided into. Also, at the end of Part 1 is an index of its players; links to jump to their entries. Above the title of each section is the link, that will take you back to the Master Table of Contents, from where you can navigate to anywhere else in the document. Finally, at the very end is a log of new entries for each update.

Notes on the Layout and Formatting

Each part is divided into sections (as listed in the tables of contents), loosely based on the kind of activity the player is involved in or the nature of the project. Note, however, that many of these players wear many hats; many are involved with or on the board of multiple corporations in disparate fields. It seems clear that there is a club, an in-crowd of team players who are on board with similar agendas who find their way into multiple corporations, as well as international organizations and projects.

For each entry (player, group, project, collaboration) their or its name is in a bold, red bullet point. For all of those listed with their own entry in bold red, whenever they appear anywhere else in the document their name will be in **bold** text.

Following the player's name, in indented paragraphs with a hanging 2nd line indent, like this one, the associations, activities, and such are listed.

Sometimes, not always, the first paragraph or a few are a general brief description of the player, group, or collaboration.

Some information is shown in bullet pointed lists to better show multiple players similarly related to the player or organization, for example funders or board members.

There are also links to sources interspersed for the much of the information. To avoid having the document ridiculously cluttered, those links do not include the title of the article or source; rather they simply look like this: ((***)**) Following some of the linked-to sources a quote may follow, in text indented left and right.

Note that many sources are from Wikipedia, a poor source for any context but probably reasonable for an individual or corporation's general resumé, albeit limited.

As well as the interspersed () links, at the end of many player's or project's entries are some links to related information. These are of two types; one is web pages, documents, or videos *from* the player or project themselves, and the other is articles or videos *about* them from various sources. Some of these links are to information related to the listed activities and collaborations, while others are not.

Created by John D. Rockefeller and son in 1913. ()
